



NIGERIA'S REV360 PLATFORM: A NEW ERA IN TAX ADMINISTRATION AND COMPLIANCE

The Rev360 platform is a newly introduced digital tax administration system developed by the Nigeria Revenue Service (NRS) to modernize and streamline tax processes across Nigeria. The Nigeria Revenue Service (NRS) has announced the planned launch of its Rev360 platform on 30 April 2026.

At its core, Rev360 represents a transition from traditional and partially digitized systems (such as TaxPro Max) to a fully integrated, intelligent tax ecosystem. It is designed to support end-to-end tax administration, meaning that taxpayers can manage the entire lifecycle of their tax obligations from registration and filing to payment, reporting, and compliance within a single platform.

A defining feature of Rev360 is its alignment with what the NRS describes as "Tax Administration 3.0." This model emphasizes:

- Automation: Reduction of manual processes through system-driven workflows
- Real-time reporting: Immediate visibility of tax positions and transactions
- System integration: Embedding tax processes directly into taxpayers' accounting and business systems

In practical terms, this means the platform is expected to:

- Improve the speed and accuracy of tax filings and assessments
- Enhance compliance monitoring through data-driven insights
- Reduce physical interaction with tax authorities
- Provide a more seamless and user-friendly experience for taxpayers

The rollout of Rev360 is being implemented in phases, beginning with Medium and Emerging Taxpayers, following a pilot program. This phased approach is intended to ensure system stability and allow taxpayers sufficient time to adapt through training and stakeholder engagement initiatives.

Overall, Rev360 signals a significant shift in Nigeria's tax administration framework toward greater transparency, efficiency, and digital integration, in line with global best practices.

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
